



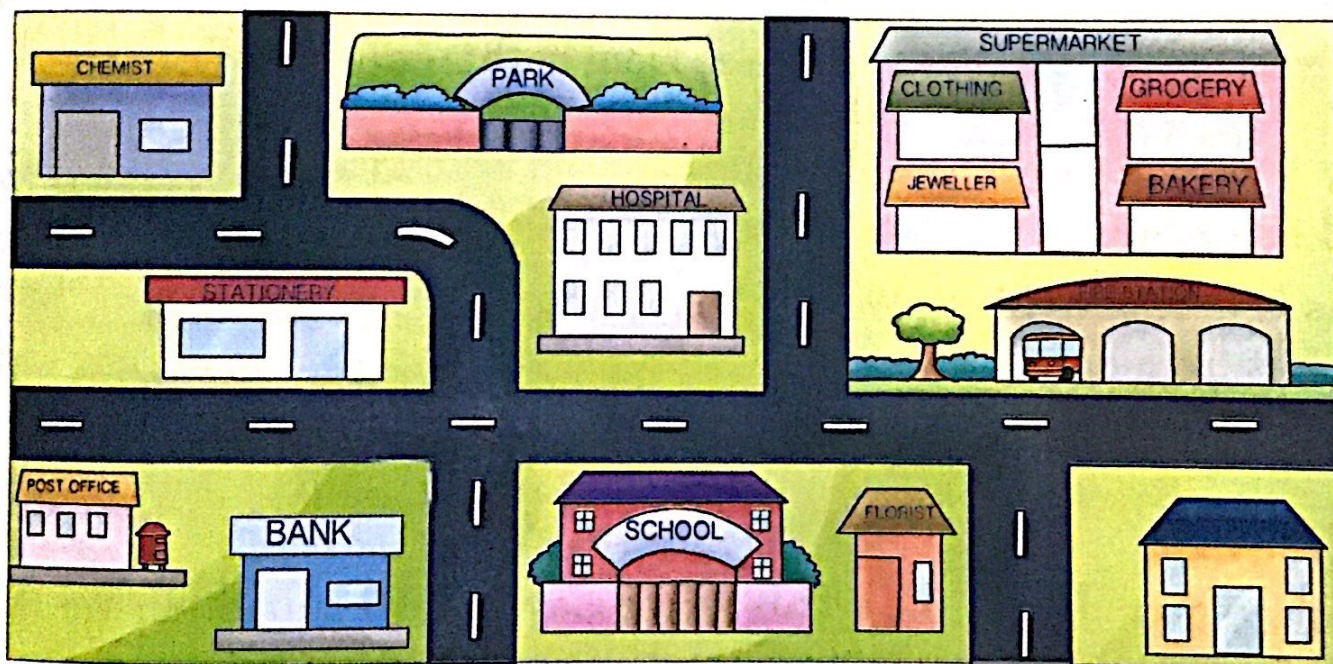
# Our Neighbourhood Services

*You already know that the places around you are your neighbourhood. There are many different places in our neighbourhood that help us in different ways.*

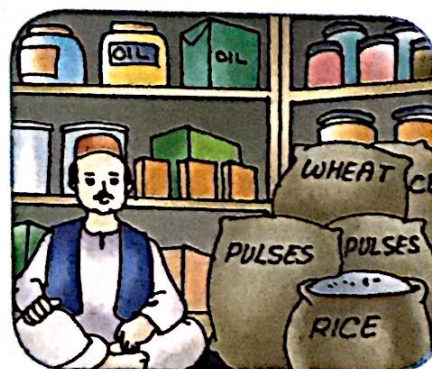
Let us see what services are available in our neighbourhood.

This is a market. Within the market there are many services that supply the things we need for our daily use.



## Grocery Store

This is a Grocery Store. It sells things like cereals, pulses, spices, sugar, edible oils, etc.







### Chemist Shop

This is a Chemist Shop. We buy medicines here.

### Stationery Shop

This is a Stationery Shop. We buy notebooks, pen, pencil, paper and other stationery items from here.



### Florist Shop

This is a Florist Shop. We buy beautiful flowers from here.

### Bakery Store

This is a Bakery Shop. We buy cakes and candies from here.

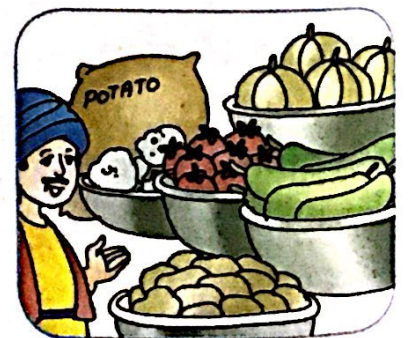


### Fruit Stall

This is a Vegetable Stall. We buy fresh vegetables from here.



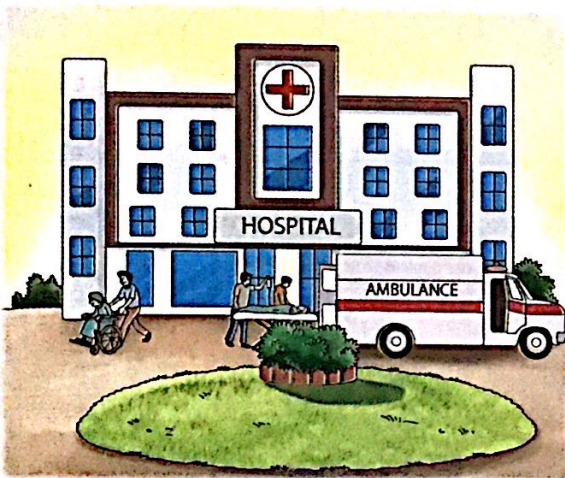
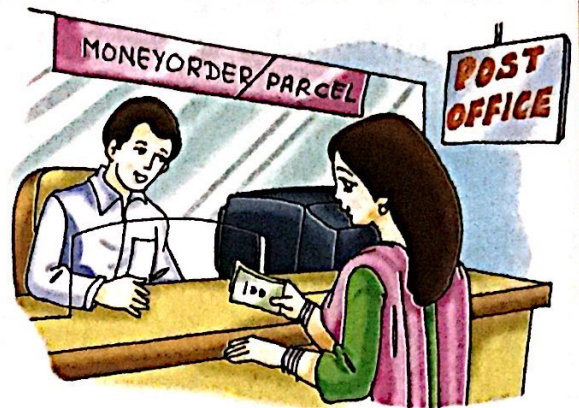


## Other Neighbourhood Services

### Post Office

### Hospital

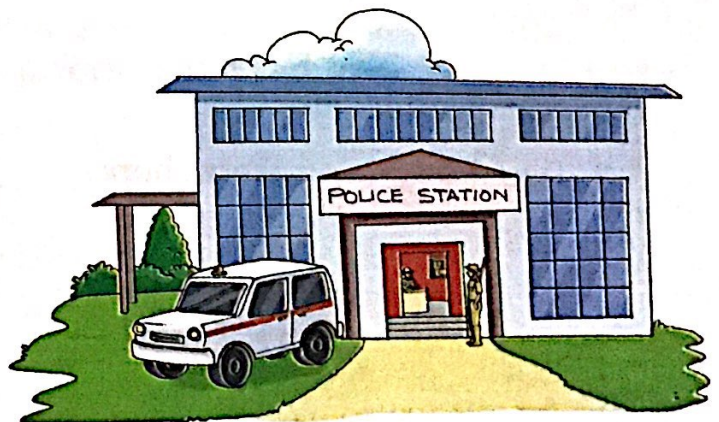
This is a Hospital. Whenever people fall sick or if they meet with an accident, they come here for treatment.

#### Fact!

Some neighbourhoods have a dispensary. A dispensary is much smaller than a hospital.

### Police Station

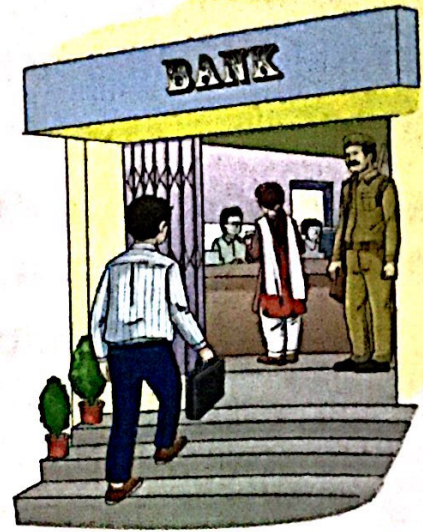
This is a Police Station. Policemen work here. Their job is to make our neighbourhood safe and secure. Thefts and accidents are reported here.





## Bank
